update on covid -19 and the lodge

A reminder to those planning to stay in the Dulmison Ski Club lodges this year that the Australian government is recommending all adults be vaccinated to prevent COVID-19. Ski fields and ski lodges were particularly affected early in the pandemic and there is no reason to suspect the NSW ski fields would be spared if there is a major Australian outbreak this winter. Noting that members and guests may not have completed vaccination by ski seasons, even having one of the two doses has been shown to significantly reduce the risk of hospitalisation from COVID-19 in UK studies. In terms of practicality of staying at the lodge this winter COVID policies/procedures will be much the same as last year (e.g. physical distancing where able and lots of hand hygiene) with the added inclusion of QR code scanning for easier declaration also meaning that visitors will be allowed to return! If any questions or queries, fear not our wonderful lodge managers will be sure to direct you on how to stay safe this season.

The club has achieved some excellent results over the years and built strong relationships with other clubs through these races. I am sure you would have seen the photos, flags and trophies we have won displayed at the Perisher and Thredbo lodges.

There is usually a Junior Interclub race at Thredbo in the July school holidays and a Senior Interclub race at Thredbo in early August. The Perisher event is held in mid-September.

Each year we call for school aged racers to compete at Thredbo when we strive for a balance of male/female racers, varying ages and diverse skill level. Similarly, we look to enter a team in the Senior races at Thredbo and Perisher Valley (Brett Williams, I nominate you).
